


#### **Delegation Report**



#### **Purpose of Visit**

The primary purpose of attending the GITEX AFRICA Conference in Marrakesh, Morocco was to represent the Republic of Sierra Leone in my capacity as the Special Envoy for Trade and Investment. Our mission was to identify and engage strategic partners who can support Sierra Leone's ambitions in bringing innovative technology and communication solutions to key sectors of our economy.

#### Preface: State of Technology in Sierra Leone

The Republic of Sierra Leone stands at a crucial crossroads in its digital development.

While significant strides have been made to expand mobile access and basic internet infrastructure, the country continues to face challenges in cyber security, system integration, and scalable digital transformation—especially within public sector institutions and private industry. With a growing demand for ICT solutions across government ministries, education, healthcare, and commerce, Sierra Leone urgently requires strategic partnerships to strengthen its digital economy and position itself as a technology-forward nation within the ECOWAS region.
